Memory and Justice in Rwanda after the 1994 genocide

Description

Location: KICUKIRO ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, Catholic schools run by Belgian missionaries.

Then: On April 11th, 1994 the Belgian soldiers who were serving in the UN peace troops led by Luc Lemaire abandoned Tutsi, who had sought refuge their military compound, to the mercy of Interahamwe. More than 5,000 were killed that day.

Now: November 13th, 2007 is the judgement day of three people alleged to have committed the heinous crime of genocide in front of those that survived the massacre.
